

Guidelines: BCIA Mentor of the Year Nominations

Purpose:

To select a BCIA Registrant who holistically espouses the values of being a BCIA mentor

Eligibility:

- Demonstrates commitment to the Mentoring Program over many years (suggest 5 year minimum)
- Actively engages with their mentee
- Recognizes that the mentoring relationship has benefited the mentee and has not simply been an administrative task
- Promotes the mentoring program and has contributed to its betterment
- Number of mentoring situations, but not at the expense of quality (i.e. not simply a numbers game)
- Part of a broader commitment to the BCIA

DOCUMENTATION FOR MENTOR OF THE YEAR

- 1. Nominating Agrologist, branch
- 2. Name of the nominee
- 3. Date and place of birth (if known)
- 4. Reason for the nomination
- 5. Contribution to the Mentoring Program
- 6. Service to the profession at the branch, provincial and national level
- 7. Honours and awards (list honors and awards already held, if known)
- 8. 1 or 2 letters of reference to strengthen the nomination optional
