

Guidelines: BCIA Mentor of the Year Nominations

Purpose:

To select a BCIA member who holistically espouses the values of being a BCIA mentor.

Eligibility:

From the region hosting the BCIA Conference & AGM

Demonstrated commitment to the mentoring program over many years (suggest 5 year minimum)

Actively engages with his or her mentoree

Recognized that the mentoring has benefited the mentoree and has not simply been an administrative task

Promotes the mentoring program and has contributed to its betterment

Number of mentoring situations, but not at the expense of quality (i.e. not simply a numbers game)

Part of a broader commitment to the BCIA

The nomination should include:

- 1. Nominating Agrologist, branch.
- 2. Name of nominee.
- 3. Date and place of birth (if known).
- 4. Reason for nomination.
- 5. Contribution to the A.Ag. program
- 6. Service to the profession at branch, provincial and national level.
- 7. Honors and awards (list honors and awards already held, if known).
- 8. Supporting letters (minimum of 2 from individuals)
