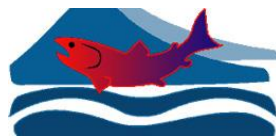
## **Fish Hatchery Tour at Noons Creek Fish Hatchery**

The PMES is a 100% volunteer-operated training organization whose mandate is to operate a salmon hatchery and water quality testing laboratory located on land owned by the City of Port Moody. They have been working for over 30 years to foster a love of the environment through education and outreach in the Tri-Cities. PMES and Noons Creek fish hatchery are situated within the traditional, ancestral and unceded territory of the Musqueam, Squamish, and Tseil-Waututh Nation (TWN).
